1. The Registry has put up the complaint before the Full Bench for consideration of the Scrutiny Report and to pass appropriate order.

2. Certain defects have been pointed out in the complaint which are as under:

“

- a) A signed notarized affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper has not been enclosed.
- b) The complainant has not furnished the name and designation of the public servant(s) against whom complaint is being made.
- c) The complainant has not furnished the post held by the public servant at the time of commission of alleged offence under the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.
- d) The complainant has not furnished the summary of facts/allegations of corruption.
- e) Although the complainant has enclosed a few documents with the complaint, he has not provided any particulars/list of the documents relied upon by him. Therefore, it cannot be ascertained whether such documents have been enclosed.
- f) A letter addressed to the Lokpal of India has not been enclosed.
- g) The complaint has been received through LokpalOnline portal. The physical copy of which has not been received in Lokpal Office for which due date is 05.07.2024.
- h) The complaint form is unsigned. ”

As there are many defects in the complaint which are required to be rectified before the complaint is taken up for consideration, we provide an opportunity to the complainant to rectify the abovementioned defects pointed out by the Bench within fifteen days from the receipt of this order i.e., on or before 25.07.2024, and submit the same to the office of Lokpal of India within the time limit granted, failing which the complaint shall be treated as disposed of.
