**ORDER**

The complaint is placed before the Full Bench for consideration of the Scrutiny Report and to pass appropriate order.

2. Perused the Scrutiny Report.



3. The complaint dated 03.07.2023 has been received through the LokpalOnline portal, therefore it is unsigned. The physical copy of the complaint has not been received. The scrutiny report in respect of this complaint points out deficiencies, viz. in Part-A, the address filled in this column is different from the address mentioned in the residence proof enclosed. Likewise, in Part-C, in the Column 1, the complainant has mentioned his own name instead of mentioning the name of the public servant against whom the complaint is being made. Besides, the complainant has not provided any list/particulars of documents relied upon in support of the allegation. In the Column No.7 of Part-C whether copies of such documents have been enclosed, the complainant has mentioned 'Yes' in this column, and he hasn't provided any list. Further, the complainant has enclosed a non-notarized, partially filled up, signed proforma of affidavit on plain paper.

4. The complaint was taken up by the Scrutiny Bench and in view of the deficiencies noted therein, the complainant was directed by the Registry of the Lokpal of India vide letter dated 03.08.2023 to give the name and other particulars of the public servant complained against and to mention specific allegations of corruption along with the proof of such corruption, if possible at an early date. However, no communication has been received from the complainant till date.

5. The complaint is against officer(s) of the Steel Authority of India Limited (SAIL) officers and the exam agency. The complaint does not disclose the name of



the official against whom the complaint has been filed. No allegation of corruption against any official can be culled out from the complaint, as filed.

6. In view of the above, we give two weeks' time to the complainant to remove the Office objections and present a complaint in the prescribed format, failing which the Registry may treat this complaint as filed and disposed of.

7. If the objections are removed in time, the matter be posted in the following date or 29.05.2024, whichever is earlier.
