**ORDER**

The complaint is placed before the Full Bench for consideration of the Scrutiny Report and to pass appropriate order.



2. The complaint is against two public servants - (i) Project Engineer of Cauvery Neeravari Nigama Niyamitha and (ii) Assistant Executive Engineer (AEE), CHESCOM **XXXXXX** Subdivision. The complaint pertains to the borewell scheme implemented by Cauvery Neeravari Nigama Niyamitha, Karnataka. The complainant alleges that despite the borewell being drilled in 2019 and the motor with pipes installed in February 2022 by the project Engineer, the power connection is still pending. The complainant has also stated that the said Project Engineer has informed that the file has been lost and that he had recently collected all relevant documents from his father. The complainant has alleged that the Assistant Executive Engineer has been unresponsive and rude and that despite follow-up on his part for the last two years, they are delaying the work.

3. As per the Scrutiny Report, there are certain deficiencies/defects in the complaint. The complaint was placed before the Scrutiny Bench and the Bench directed to inform the complainant to remove the deficiencies in the complaint and furnish the necessary details. Accordingly, a letter dated 05.03.2024 was issued to the complainant so that the deficiencies are removed. It is seen that the complainant has not yet taken action to cure the deficiencies.

4. The complainant is granted two weeks further time to cure the defects, pointed out by the Registry as a last opportunity. That shall be done within two weeks from the date of receipt of the intimation along with the present Order from the Registry, failing which the complaint shall be disposed of without any further reference to us.



5. Registry to take necessary steps. Registry to inform the complainant also Online/email, from where the Online complaint was forwarded. Ordered accordingly.
