ORDER

Perused the complaint.

The complainant has alleged that he was asked to pay bribe by the named public servants for preventing disposal and alienation of his property through third party auction. He has alleged that on his refusal to pay the bribe, the named public servants sold his property at under-valued price. He has also alleged that the public servants are also involved in illegal activities in respect of other NPA accounts of the bank and illegally enriching themselves.

After considering the complaint, it appears that the complainant has not adduced any evidence in support of his allegations of demand of money by the concerned public servants. Moreover, it is seen that in his affidavit filed along with the complaint, he has stated that he has not made complaint

on this issue with any other authority. However, a copy of the complaint addressed to CVC is also enclosed with the complaint in which details of the case have been given. It is also mentioned in the letter that an application on the same issue was made before Hon'ble Lokayukta, Odisha. In that case, the complaint made with the Lokpal of India will be hit by Section 15 of the Lokpal & Lokayuktas Act, 2013. This Bench, therefore, is not inclined to pass any order in the matter. However, the complainant is at liberty to pursue his complaint with the appropriate authorities.

The complaint, accordingly, stands disposed of.
