**ORDER**

The complaint has been listed today before the Full Bench along with the Scrutiny Report.



The complaint is against the Collector and District Magistrate, Dakshin Dinajpur, West Bengal. It is informed that the complainant was given the work of data entry for creation of an information bank of migrant people by the Respondent Public Servant which he completed and submitted along with the bills to the authorities. It is alleged that no payment was made to the complainant despite follow up with various authorities.

The complaint was received through Lokpal Online portal as well as by post. As per the Scrutiny Report, the complainant had not filed the identify proof and the proof of residence due to which the information given in Part-A of the complaint cannot be verified. The complainant has also not given a list of documents relied upon by him at S.No.12 in Part-C of the complaint, therefore, it cannot be ascertained whether documents have been enclosed.

The complaint was initially placed before the Scrutiny Bench which had directed to inform the complainant to provide identify proof and the proof of residence. Accordingly, a letter dated 05.01.2024 was sent to the complainant, however, the complainant has not sent any further communication/replies.

The complainant had earlier filed a similar complaint regarding non-payment of his dues which was registered as Complaint No.2270/2022. The said complaint was disposed of vide Order dated 06.05.2022 of the Full Bench.

It is to be noted that the complaint does not disclose any corruption angle. Moreover, the complaint is against an official working under the State Government of West Bengal. Hence, it does not warrant any action on the part of the Lokpal of India as the RPS does not come within the jurisdiction of the Lokpal as per the provisions of Lokpal & Lokayuktas Act, 2013.



Accordingly, the complaint is disposed of. The complainant is at liberty to pursue his grievance before the appropriate forum.
