**ORDER**

Perused the Scrutiny Report.



2. The complaint is at the Diary stage and placed before the Full Bench. The Full Bench examined the complaint.
  
3. The complainant has submitted this complaint through Lokpal Online portal on 04.01.2024 and the physical copy has not been submitted yet. After placing it in the scrutiny bench, certain defects were observed and the complainant was directed to resubmit the complaint after removing deficiencies mentioned within four weeks, vide Letter No. S-12016/13/2024-Lokpal/127 dated 12.02.2024 of Lokpal of India. No response has been received from the complainant till now.
  
4. This complaint is against the illegal encroachment of complainant's property. It seems that the complainant is one of the parties to the dispute pertaining to illegal encroachment of land which is pending before the Hon'ble Court of SDM, Tehsil Tanda, Ambedkar Nagar District. The complainant has mentioned that his land was illegally encroached upon. The Court has issued an order in the said matter/case with the directions to maintain Status Quo in respect of the disputed land until settlement of the case. He has further stated that the police took the action against the complainant instead of the opposite party.



5. The scrutiny branch addressed vide letter dated 12.2.2024 to the complainant apprising him to remove the deficiencies. However, he has not responded to it till now.

6. On scrutiny of this incomplete complaint the Full Bench has observed that complainant has not alleged corruption against any public servant within the meaning of Section 14 of the Lokpal and Lokayuktas Act, 2013.

7. In view of the above, the Full Bench is of the opinion that the grievance is about civil dispute and the complainant has already approached the Civil Court in the matter, which is sub-judice. Therefore, no intervention is required at this stage.



8. Accordingly, the complaint is disposed of.
