**ORDER**

The Registry has put up the complaint for consideration of the Full Bench.

2. It is noticed that the complainant has not filed notarized affidavit with the complaint. The complainant has also not attached any letter addressed to the Lokpal of India or any other document in support of the allegations. However, based on one of the documents attached with the complaint it is gathered that the complaint is against Assistant Commissioner of Police of U.P. The complainant



has alleged that the public servant takes bribe for filing fake FIRs without investigation and is involved in corruption and illegal activities at Police Station. The complainant has also mentioned about various illicit activities in the area such as oil theft from tankers, illegal business of drugs, illegal sand mining along the river etc.

3. We have considered the complaint and dispose to condone the remarks made in the Scrutiny Report. We find that it is against the official working in the State of Uttar Pradesh and not against the public servant who is connected with the affairs of the Union. This public servant does not fall within the jurisdiction of Lokpal of India as per Section 14 of the Lokpal and Lokayuktas Act, 2013.

4. Accordingly the complaint is disposed of. Needless to say the complainant would be at liberty to seek redressal of his grievance before any appropriate forum.
