ORDER

The complaint is placed before the Full Bench for consideration of the Scrutiny Report and to pass appropriate order.

2. Perused the Scrutiny Report.



3. The complaint dated 24.04.2024 has been received through the LokpalOnline portal, therefore it is unsigned. The physical copy of the complaint has not been received. The scrutiny report has pointed out various deficiencies in Part-A and Part-C of the form of complaint in respect of this complaint.
4. We deem it appropriate to condone the remarks made in the Scrutiny Report.
5. The complaint is against a Cashier of Central Bank of India, Jhalawar District of Rajasthan. The complainant has alleged that when he went to the bank to withdraw his mother's pension, the said Cashier misbehaved with him and denied the withdrawal even after the Branch Manager gave him permission to do so. The complainant has mentioned that his mother got paralyzed since last one year as a result she could not withdraw her pension nor able to do KYC. The complainant has requested to take action against the Cashier and to render justice to him.
6. The Full Bench having perused the complaint and the document attached with the complaint is of the view that the complaint contains various deficiencies and has no discernible allegation of commission of an offence of corruption as defined under the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.



7. In view of the above, we are not inclined to entertain this complaint. Hence, no order needs to be passed in the matter. The complainant is free to pursue such other remedy as may be permissible in law. We should not be understood to have expressed any opinion either way on the merits of the grievance in this complaint in that regard.

8. Accordingly, the complaint is disposed of.
