ORDER

Perused the complaint.

2. This complaint has been received through the Lokpal Online Portal and no physical copy of the complaint has been submitted by the complainant, despite two written reminders. The complainant has also not fulfilled the requirement of filing a notarised affidavit or provided any proof of identity.

3. From the material before us, comprising of Part C of the Complaint Format and a letter dated 12.02.2022 from an advocate, it can be deduced that the complaint is directed against an Additional District and Sessions Judge, FTC II, Kushinagar, Uttar Pradesh, for alleged inaction in providing relief in a case, wherein directions have purportedly been issued by the Hon'ble Allahabad



High Court and the Uttar Pradesh State Human Rights Commission.

4. Apart from being deficient in details, the present complaint relates to a Judicial Officer of the State of Uttar Pradesh, falling under the purview of the jurisdictional High Court. The Lokpal of India would, therefore, not be inclined to go into the matter.

5. The complainant is at liberty to pursue his complaint before the appropriate authority.

6. In view of the above, the complaint is disposed of.
