**ORDER**

1. The complaint has been placed before the Full Bench along with the Scrutiny Report for consideration and orders.
2. The Scrutiny Report point out the following defects:-



- (i) The complainant has not furnished the name and designation of the public servant against whom the complaint has been made.
- (ii) The complainant has not furnished the post held by the public servant at the time of commission of alleged offence under the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.
- (iii) Although the complainant has enclosed a few documents with the complaint, he has not provided any particulars/list of the documents relied upon by him. Therefore, it cannot be ascertained whether such documents have been relied as evidence in support of his complaint.

3. We have perused the complaint and gone through the documents enclosed along with it. However, we are disposed to condone the remarks made by the office in the Scrutiny Report and proceed with the complaint.

4. It appears that the complainant has a grievance against the Municipal Corporation of Karimnagar, Telangana. It is found that the grievance of the complainant can at best be against the public servants working in the affairs of the Municipal Corporation of Karimnagar, Telangana which does not fall within the purview of Section 14 of the Lokpal and Lokayuktas Act, 2013. The named public servant is not amenable to the jurisdiction of Lokpal of India, hence, the complaint is being disposed



of accordingly. However, the complainant is at liberty to approach the appropriate authority for redressal of his grievance if he so desires.
