## **ORDER**

Perused the complaint.

2. This complaint has been filed by a former Executive Engineer (EE), Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD), against two serving EEs (Bldg-II) Central Zone and their staff, for not demolishing the allegedly unauthorised construction of "Cosmos Public School" and for trying to save the said unauthorised construction. The said construction is stated to be situated in the Eco Sensitive Zone – O, where no construction activity is permitted and there is likely to be danger to the school children. It is alleged by the complainant that he was punished, illegally, for taking action, whereas the public servants concerned are hand-in-glove to save the unauthorised construction.

- 3. The complainant states that he has made several complaints to the MCD but, as their staff is complicit in the alleged illegal activities, he has approached the Lokpal of India, with a prayer for a direction to demolish the entire construction.
- 4. We have perused the complaint and the documents attached therewith. There are no allegations of corruption in the matter, whatsoever. The grievance of the complainant appears to be regarding unauthorised construction only.
- 5. In the absence of any allegations or details regarding alleged corruption or quid pro quo by the public servants concerned, the Lokpal of India would not be inclined to interfere. The complaint does not meet the requirements of the Lokpal and Lokayuktas Act, 2013, therefore, does not justify further consideration.
- 6. Accordingly, the complaint stands disposed of.
