ORDER

Perused the complaint.

2. The complaint has been received through LokpalOnline portal and a physical copy of the complaint has also been received. Although certain deficiencies were noted in the complaint, it was decided to condone these and take a decision on the complaint based upon the details made available and on the merits of the case.

3. The complaint has been filed against an officer working in the Asansol Division of Eastern Railway of the Indian Railways. The allegations against the said official include – misuse of the official vehicle, false entries in the log book and avoidable expenditure on reimbursement of TA Bills of railway staff.

4. The Full Bench having considered the complaint is of the view that the subject matter of the complaint is not covered by the mandate provided to the Lokpal of India under the Lokpal and Lokayuktas Act, 2013. Therefore,



no order needs to be passed in this case. The Full Bench decided to refer this complaint to Railway Board for necessary action at their end. Complainant is also at liberty to pursue his case at appropriate levels.

5. Registry, Lokpal of India is directed to take action accordingly.
6. With these observations, the complaint is disposed of.
