ORDER

Perused the complaint.

2. As the complaint dated April 07, 2021 sent through email was not in the prescribed format as per Rules, the complainant was informed by the Registry, Lokpal of India through an email dated February 25, 2022 to file his complaint as per the form prescribed under the Rules. However, the complainant has not done this so far. Yet, in the interest of justice, the complaint is being considered and is being decided upon on merits.

3. The complainant has referred to an appeal dated 15.03.2021 addressed to the Managing Director of Bengal Chemicals and Pharmaceuticals Limited (BCPL) for proper appreciation of the grievance of the complainant. The Registry of the Lokpal of India vide letter dated 21st June, 2022 wrote to the complainant requesting him to furnish the documents that he had sought from MD, BCPL or any other authority and it was also requested to furnish a copy of the appeal filed by him. In the said letter it was also specifically mentioned that the requisite information/documents should reach the Registry of Lokpal of India within three (03) weeks of receipt of the communication.




4. As nothing was heard from the complainant, another letter was sent to him on 20th July, 2022 by the Registry of Lokpal of India requesting him to furnish the information without any further delay.

5. It is seen that more than eight months have elapsed since the last communication with the complainant and the complainant has not furnished any information/documents as required. Further, the email sent by him on April 07, 2021 is also not clear.

6. In view of the above, we do not wish to proceed further in this matter.

7. With these remarks, the complaint is disposed of.
