ORDER

This complaint has been filed against three public servants serving in the Delhi Police and posted at the Shalimar Bagh Police Station. The names and designations of the said public servants have been mentioned in the complaint.

- 2. The complainant has levelled allegations regarding a demand for bribes, in return of a favourable report for the issuance of an Arms Licence to him. According to the complainant, when he refused to pay the bribes, the concerned public servants manipulated the record and gave an incorrect report.
- 3. The complaint was put up before the Full Bench of The Lokpal of India, on 21.12.2023. After considering the complaint, the Full Bench directed the Commissioner of Police, Delhi, to look into the matter and submit his comments by 29.01.2024.
- 4. The comments, as above, have been received vide letter dated 29.01.2024. A perusal thereof indicates that the

complainant is habitual in making several complaints against various people. A complaint was made against him regarding issuance threats, due to which his earlier application for grant of an Arms Licence, was not recommended. Thereafter, the complainant applied for an Arms Licence afresh in the month of June 2023. Pursuant to this application, the concerned public servant recommended the grant of an Arms Licence to the complainant, in the absence of any adverse report.

- 5. Regarding the allegations of bribery, it is stated that the complainant could not provide any details or evidence in this regard. Hence these allegations could not be substantiated.
- 6. After perusal of the comments of the Commissioner of Police, Delhi, we find that there is no substance in the complaint. The complainant appears to be engaged in filing sundry complaints against several persons. As there is no evidence, whatsoever, regarding the demand or payment of a bribe by/to, any public servant, the complaint deserves no further scrutiny.
- 7. Accordingly, the complaint is closed and stands disposed of.
