ORDER

1. The complaint has been placed before the Full Bench of Lokpal along with the Scrutiny Report which points out following defects:-
 - a. The complainant has not provided his name. He has mentioned "KKK" in S.No.2 of Part A of the Complaint Form.
 - b. The complainant has provided neither any identify proof nor any address proof with the complaint form.



- c. The complainant has not enclosed a duly signed notarised affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper.
 - d. The statement of allegations enclosed by the complainant has not been signed.
 - e. The complaint has been received through Lokpal Online portal, however, the physical copy of the same has not been received.
2. As per the 'Statement of Allegations', the complaint is against the Controller of Examinations, Tamil Nadu Dr. Ambedkar Law University. The complainant has alleged that there is misconduct and corruption going on within the University. It is alleged that the students are permitted to engage in cheating during examinations, inaccuracies are present in academic records, additional internal marks are awarded to favourable students. Further, the complainant proposes the installation of surveillance cameras on campus to mitigate cheating and also recommended that private colleges should refrain administering their own examinations.
3. As per the complainant, the Respondent Public Servant (RPS) is working as Controller of Examinations in Tamil Nadu Dr. Ambedkar Law University. The said University has been established by the Government of Tamil Nadu by an Act of State Legislature (Act No.43 of 1997) for the advancement and dissemination of knowledge in learning, teaching and research in the field of law. The RPS is in no



way working in relation with the affairs of the Central Government. There is no assertion that the staff of such University would come within one of the clauses of sub-section (1) of Section 14 of the Lokpal & Lokayuktas Act, 2013.

4. In view of above, the present complaint is not maintainable in view of Section 14 of the Lokpal & Lokayuktas Act, 2013. No fruitful purpose would be served in granting time to the complainant to remove the defects.
5. Accordingly, the complaint stands disposed of with liberty to the complainant to pursue other appropriate remedy permissible in law, if so advised.
