ORDER

1. The complaint is placed before the Full Bench for consideration of the Scrutiny Report and to pass appropriate order.
2. Perused the Scrutiny Report.



3. The complaint dated 30.11.2024 has been received through the Lokpal Online Portal. The Scrutiny Report has pointed out the following defects:-
- (i) Although the complainant has enclosed a copy of Aadhar Card, the information on it is not legible.
 - (ii) The complaint has not enclosed a notarized affidavit with the complaint; only an unsigned proforma of the affidavit generated by the LokpalOnline portal has been uploaded.
 - (iii) A signed statement of allegations by the complainant has not been enclosed.
 - (iv) The complaint has been received through the Lokpal Online Portal, however, the physical copy of the same has not been received. Since the parts of the complaint form are generated by the Lokpal Online Portal, the same are unsigned.
4. We deem it appropriate to condone the defects pointed out in the Scrutiny Report and entertain this complaint.
5. The complaint is against a Sub-Inspector and two Head Constables of the Uttar Pradesh Police, Government of Uttar Pradesh. The complainant has alleged that the police officials had harassed and detained him unlawfully after he refused to pay bribe. During custody, he was allegedly coerced into a fabricated theft case by being forced to handle broken solar panels and recorded a confession video under threats of an encounter. Further, the complainant claims that despite submitting applications to senior officials and the District Magistrate, no action has been taken to address the false allegations or secure the CCTV footage. The complainant has attached documents like an unsigned letter addressed to Shriman Lokayukta Mahoday, Bharat;



General Diary Details, FIR, some information sought under RTI, etc. with the complaint.

6. The Full Bench perused the complaint and the documents attached with the complaint. The public servants against whom the complaint is made are serving in connection with the affairs of the State Government of Uttar Pradesh. As such the said public servants are not amenable to the jurisdiction of the Lokpal as per Section 14 of the Lokpal and Lokayuktas Act, 2013.
7. Consequently, the complaint is disposed of.
8. The complainant will, however, be at liberty to approach appropriate authority for the redressal of his grievance.
