ORDER

Perused the complaint.

The complaint has been perused by the Full Bench of Lokpal for consideration of the Scrutiny Report and pass appropriate order.

Perused the Scrutiny Report. The office has pointed out that the complainant has filled the complaint form with error in S.No.13 of Part-C of the complaint form. In column 13 of Part-C, the complainant had to furnish the supporting



documents/information which may be relevant to enquire/investigation into the allegation of corruption, however, the column has been left blank by the complainant.

We deem appropriate to condone the remarks made by the office in the Scrutiny Report and entertain the complaint.

The complaint has been made against an Assistant Engineer (AC&R), AIIMS, Raipur, Chhattisgarh. The complainant has alleged that the permanent public servant had applied for the post of Junior Engineer (AC&R) by concealing his actual qualification in which he has declared of having Diploma in 'Mechanical Engineering' and 'Refrigeration and Air-Conditioning' certificate from Industrial Training Institute (ITI), Bhiwani and the specified qualification for the post required a three-year Diploma in 'Mechanical Engineering' along with a specified course in 'Refrigeration and Air-Conditioning' from a recognized institute. The complainant and the accused public servant both took the written examination followed by document verification, however, only the accused public servant was declared successful in the final result while the complainant's candidature was rejected for unknown reasons.

The complainant claims that the appointment of the public servant as Junior Engineer (AC&R) does not meet the essential qualifications required for the post advertised and as such the public servant had obtained the appointment on the post of Junior Engineer (AC&R) by concealing his actual qualification. Thus, he obtained the appointment order fraudulently. The complainant has requested that the entire records pertaining to the appointment of the public servant as Junior Engineer (AC&R) shall be called and direct the authority under AIIMS, Raipur to set aside the selection of the public servant and consequently appointment order and terminate the appointment of the public servant from the post of Junior Engineer (AC&R) in AIIMS, Raipur, Chhattisgarh.

The issue involved in the matter is about appointment/service matter of a public servant. Moreover, there are no specific allegations of corruption against the public servant. The redressal of the grievance of the complainant does not lie in the domain of the Lokpal of India.



Hence, no order needs to be passed in the matter. Accordingly, the complaint stands disposed of.
