**ORDER**

The complainant in this matter had filed a complaint earlier against the same public servant, i.e. an ACP of Delhi Police on which action was taken under complaint No.27/2020. In view of the serious allegations raised against the said police officer, the Full Bench of the Lokpal of India had directed the authorities concerned to take disciplinary action against him and also recommended to transfer him out of Delhi because his presence in Delhi could have affected the inquiry. In compliance, he was transferred out of Delhi to Andaman and Nicobar Island, Port Blair in December, 2021. As reported in the letter dated 15<sup>th</sup> September, 2022 of DSP, Police Headquarter, Port Blair, the Officer had joined duty at Police Headquarters, Andaman & Nicobar Island on 21<sup>st</sup> January, 2022 and superannuated from service on 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2022. However, he was placed under suspension with immediate effect. Having perused the documents received from the CVC intimating about the action being taken in the matter, the Full Bench was of the view that no further intervention was required at our level in this connection. The complaint was, therefore, disposed of vide Order dated 18.01.2023 of the Full Bench.

2. The instant complaint has been filed by the complainant against the same public servant, alleging that he, in connivance with his close associate, had implicated him in a false and frivolous case in order to take revenge and bring him under pressure, which was registered by Delhi Police in FIR No.53/2022 u/s 307/341/34 IPC at PS Govindpuri. The complainant further alleged that this associate of the Police Officer had a bad criminal record and was arrested by the CBI in 2010. As the complainant apprehended harm to him and his family from the said police officer, he requested the Lokpal to pass an order providing protection to him and his family. This complaint was placed before the Full Bench on 5<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 and it was decided to seek a status report from the Commissioner of Police, Delhi on or before 30<sup>th</sup> August, 2022.

3. As the status report was not received within the prescribed time limit, reminders were sent by the Office of the Lokpal of India on 16.11.2022 and 08.02.2023 to the Office of the Commissioner of Police, Delhi. Vide letter dated 10.05.2023, Vigilance Cell of Delhi Police has forwarded the Status Report dated 07.03.2023 of the DCP, South East District, Sarita Vihar, New Delhi. It is submitted in this Report that based on a PCR call received on 14.01.2022 by the Delhi Police regarding knife attack on the father of the caller, the police visited the hospital and recorded the statements of three injured persons. In his statement, the injured father of the caller held the complainant and his two associates responsible for attacking him. He stated that the complainant and his associates came to his shop and demanded Rs.50,000/- from him. As he refused to pay, the complainant allegedly asked his friend to attack him and that the complainant would take care of the consequences. Then he was attacked with a knife as a result of which he fell down on the ground and tried to run away. Hearing his cries, the other two persons, who rushed to help him, were also attacked by the accused. By that time, some nearby people had also rushed and the accused fled away from the spot.

4. Based on the statement of the injured persons, FIR was lodged by the police in the matter, investigation was conducted and the accused were arrested. It is mentioned in the status report that the medical certificate of the injured persons disclosed lacerated and stab wounds on them. The complainant is one of the accused in this case. The Delhi police has strongly denied the allegation of the complainant of having registered any false case against him and has added that "*it seems that he filed the present complaints to hamper the investigation of the case*". It is also submitted by the Delhi Police that if the complainant still perceives any threat to his life, he may be directed to contact the jurisdiction Police Station.

5. In view of the detailed and categorical report of the Delhi Police, it is obvious that the complainant has not disclosed full facts before us. Under the circumstances, we do not consider it necessary to intervene further in the matter.

6. Accordingly, the complaint is disposed of.
