ORDER

Perused the complaints.

2. The complaints (*in Hindi*) sent via an email dated August 10, 2021 along with enclosures is addressed to several authorities in the Education Department, Fire Department, Collector (Lucknow), Registrar of Societies, Lokayukta, UP; Chief Secretary (UP), etc. in Government of Uttar Pradesh with a copy to Lokpal of India, Supreme Court and others. The complaints are not in the format prescribed under the relevant rules. Therefore, the complainant was informed by way of an email dated March 30, 2022 by the Registry of the Lokpal of India to file his complaint as per the format prescribed. However, the complainant has not done this so far. Despite this, in the interest of justice, it was decided to take up these complaints and decide upon on merits.

3. **In respect of Complaint No.3696/2022:** The complainant who claims to be an Engineer, Journalist and Social Worker and Founder & Chairman of an organization under the name and style - 'TAHRIR' - Transparency, Accountability & Human Rights Initiative for Revolution (Regd.) has received a complaint in the organization helpline that the school named in the complaint which is running in Lucknow has not completed all the fire safety standards and norms and the school building is unsafe. It is alleged that the management of the school has indulged in fraudulent ways of getting registration etc. The complainant wants action to be taken for these irregularities.
4. Complaint No.3843/2022 is not a complaint but a communication from the above complainant informing that he may be called if the matter is urgent.
5. Having considered the subject matter of the complaints, the Bench is of the view that prima-facie, the subject is not covered by the mandate provided to the Lokpal under the Lokpal and Lokayuktas Act, 2013. Hence, no order needs to be passed in these cases. The complainant may pursue his matter with the appropriate authorities.
6. Accordingly, the complaints are disposed of.
