- 4. The complainant, who claims to be 63 years old and also claims that her husband is not keeping well, has filed three (03) complaints through emails, addressed to various finance companies with copies to Lokpal of India. The request in these emails is for restructuring of the loan due to COVID and lockdown effects, as per the RBI Notification dated 05.05.2021.
- 5. It is observed that similar complaints have been dealt with earlier as Complaint No(s). 3010, 3638, 3639, 3487, 2972, 3449, 3444, 3403, 3402, 3401, 3915, 3526, 3531, 3354, 3339, 3363 and 3362/2022 and order thereupon has been passed by the Full Bench of Lokpal of India, on 17th August, 2022. Therefore, no separate order is required to be passed in these matters. The order passed earlier is applicable to these cases also.
- 6. Accordingly, these complaints stand disposed of. The complainant is at liberty to approach appropriate forum for redressal of her grievance.
