ORDER

Perused the status report dated 06.03.2023 received from the Policy Division of the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) vide letter No.DP0992022/608/33/11/2023/Lokpal(1)/PD/ in compliance with the Order of the Full Bench of the Lokpal of India dated 05.01.2023 in respect of Complaint No.3813/2022.

2. The complainant had alleged that some politically connected persons, in collusion with the officials of CBI had planned a conspiracy against her and had filed a false complaint in CBI in June, 2020. Vide Order of 05.01.2023, the Full Bench had directed that the matter be looked into by a senior official in the CBI and a report may be submitted on the action taken. In compliance thereof, a report dated 06.03.2023 has been received from the Policy Division of CBI.

3. The Division Bench has perused the aforesaid report. From the report, it is seen that a charge sheet has been filed against the complainant before us and some others under relevant sections of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) and the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988. From the report, it also appears that the said charge sheet was filed after an investigation in the trap case in which the complainant appears to be involved. It is also seen that the Learned Court has framed charges against the complainant and the matter is presently at the stage of prosecution evidence. The Division Bench is of the view that if the complainant before us has any grievance in respect



of trap case, the respective court that has framed charges, would be the appropriate forum to raise such issues.

4. From the Report, it is also seen that the allegations made by the complainant before us, alleging that someone has demanded a bribe from her, are not substantiated. The text of the chats annexed with the complaint is not clear and nothing much can be made out of these messages.

5. The Division Bench is therefore, of the view that this is not a case requiring any further action by the Lokpal of India. Hence, no order needs to be passed in this case.

6. The complaint is accordingly disposed of.
