ORDER

Perused the complaint.

2. The complainant has filed this complaint on the online portal. Though some deficiencies were observed and the complainant was given time to make good those deficiencies, he has not removed the deficiencies so far. Despite this, it was decided to take up the complaint and take a decision thereupon on the merits of the case.

3. The complainant has filed a complaint against officials of the State Bank of India, Bandhan Bank, Canara Bank and Punjab National Bank. He has alleged that the concerned officials of these banks have failed to furnish him information about certain loans advanced to some individuals. The complainant has alleged that several loanees of these banks have not repaid the loans advanced and these bank accounts have turned into Non-Performing Assets (NPA). The complainant has written to several authorities including the Central Vigilance Commission (CVC) about his grievance. It

appears that he has not been furnished with the information that he is seeking. At some places in his complaint, he has alleged that the concerned bank officials are trying to save those loanees whose bank accounts have turned into NPA in lieu of bribe or illegal gratification.

4. We have carefully perused the complaint and the documents attached with the complaint. The complainant has not furnished any evidence in support of the allegation of corruption that he has made in his complaint. Though he has mentioned that he is attaching documents that he is relying upon in support of the allegations made, no such documents are attached. The complainant has also failed to list the names of the witness in support of his allegation.

5. In view of the above and in the absence of any evidence, we are not inclined to interfere in this matter. Therefore, no order requires to be passed under the Lokpal and Lokayuktas Act, 2013. The complainant is at liberty to continue to pursue his grievance with the appropriate authorities.

6. Accordingly, the complaint is disposed of.
