ORDER

The complaint has been filed by an officer, retired in the year 2021 as Assistant Commercial Manager, Allahabad, North Central Railway. The complaint is against the Principal Chief Personnel Officer (P.C.P.O.), North Western Railway, Jaipur, for not taking action to resolve certain pay related issues of the complainant.

2. The complainant has alleged that while he was working as Divisional Commercial Inspector, North Western Railway, Jaipur, before his promotion to the post of ACM, Allahabad, his grievances relating to pay fixation under MACP (Modified Assured Career Progression Scheme), restoration of pay which was reduced in 2018, payment of arrears and allowances, treatment of

leave taken during Covid-19 pandemic as special casual leave as per the government guidelines, etc. were not acted upon by the said P.C.P.O. He has added that the said inaction of the P.C.P.O., allegedly due to an ulterior motive, has resulted in monetary loss including loss in pensionary benefits to the complainant.

- 3. The complainant has further alleged that no action was taken by the Railway Administration to redress his grievances submitted in Pension Adalat, headed by the said P.C.P.O., in December 2021 and also through CPENGRAMS (Centralized Pensioners' Grievance Redress and Monitoring System), even after one year of his retirement. He has requested for intervention of the Lokpal.
- 4. Having perused the complaint, we are of the view that the inputs provided are not sufficient to establish any corruption angle and the matter does not appear to fall under our jurisdiction.
- 5. Accordingly, the complaint is disposed of. The complainant is at liberty to pursue the matter with the authorities concerned for redressal of his grievances.
