ORDER

1. The complaint is placed before the Bench for consideration of the Scrutiny Report and to pass appropriate order.
2. Perused the Scrutiny Report.
3. The complaint dated 27.03.2025 has been received through post.
The Scrutiny Report has pointed out the following defects:-



- (i) *An authorization document authorizing the signatory to file the complaint on behalf of the association of persons has not been found enclosed with the complaint.*
- (ii) *The complainant has not mentioned the name of one of the three public servants complained against.*

4. The Bench is of the opinion that even if we were to condone the defects, no fruitful purpose would be served for the reasons mentioned hereunder.
5. From the complaint and the documents attached with the complaint it is seen that the complaint has been made against a Director General of Police (DGP) and two Sub-Inspectors attached with the DGP who are working in the State Government and the allegation is that of misusing and abusing of powers by initiating false criminal proceedings against the Complainant even though a compromise deal was arrived at in a Civil suit. It is also alleged that the public servants are conspiring with the rival defendants of the Complainant in a civil property to illegally transfer the physical possession of the property in dispute. It is further alleged that the Complainant and his family were tortured by the public servants and they were even detained.

6. The Bench perused the complaint and the documents attached with the complaint. The public servants against whom the complaint is made are serving in connection with the affairs of the State Government. As such the said public servants are not amenable to the jurisdiction of the Lokpal as per Section 14 of the Lokpal and Lokayuktas Act, 2013.
7. Consequently, the complaint is disposed of.
8. The complainant will, however, be at liberty to approach appropriate authority for the redressal of his grievance.
