<u>ORDER</u>

The complaint is placed before the Full Bench for consideration of scrutiny report to pass appropriate order.

2. The complainant is a resident of Dulhapur, District Gazipur, Uttar Pradesh. Vide present complaint seeks action against seven police officials including the



Superintendent of Police of District Gazipur, Uttar Pradesh of having misbehaved with him and forcibly took him to district hospital.

- 3. It is alleged that, when he had gone to file a complaint of theft and misbehavior against the accused person, a false case against the complainant has been registered instead of registering the case against the accused person. It is also alleged that said police officials looted the cash, car, helmet, ATM card belonging to the complainant and conspired against him when his medical condition was not well and whilst being treated in the government hospital.
- 4. To substantiate the allegations made in the complaint, the complainant has filed a copy of FIR No.0122/2018 dated 15.10.2018 lodged by the complainant's wife as well as a copy of FIR No.0030/2023 dated 15.02.2023 lodged by the person against whom FIR No.0122/2018 dated 15.10.2018 has been lodged.
- 5. On these allegations, the complainant seeks action against the aforesaid police officials posted in district Gazipur.
- 6. Evidently, the public servants against whom the action is sought are working in connection with the affairs of the State of Uttar Pradesh and there is no iota of evidence on record to suggest that they are working in connection with the affairs of the Union.
- 7. In view of above and taking into consideration the provision contained in Section 14 of the Lokpal and Lokayuktas Act, 2013, we refrain to examine the allegations made by the complainant.
- 8. Consequently, the matter stands closed and is disposed off accordingly.



9. Needless to say the complainant if so advised will be at liberty to seek redressal of his grievances before an appropriate Authority.
